**About:** This prominent building, which belongs to the University of Porto, is part of an important complex, mostly built in the 19th century, which characterises the urban and architectural structure of the Campo Alegre axis in the city of Porto, along with, for example, the Burmester House (now the House of Books) or the Anderson House (Biodiversity Gallery), all of which belong to the University of Porto. The building complex known as Círculo Universitário do Porto was rebuilt between 1986 and 1988 to a design by the architect Fernando Távora - from the renowned Porto School of Architecture. The romantic, English-inspired garden was also remodelled and adapted by landscape architect Francisco Caldeira Cabral (1908-1992).
